## **Board Member Hyland Challenges NAFCU Attendees**

*Alexandria, Va., July 26, 2010* – National Credit Union Administration Board Member Gigi Hyland challenged credit unions to take advantage of the many opportunities before them in facing the current economic crisis on July 23, 2010, when addressing attendees at the 43rd Annual Conference and Exhibition of the National Association of Federal Credit Unions.

"While the credit union system faces many challenges, credit unions still need to explore new avenues to serve everyone within their field of membership. This includes assuring that your board, management and staff members are as diverse in age, gender and ethnicity as your membership," Hyland stated.

Hyland also urged credit unions to engage in more, but responsible, member business lending and to take advantage of the new small dollar lending regulation being promulgated by NCUA. Additionally, Hyland reviewed current economic trends, credit union trends and regulatory issues with attendees.
